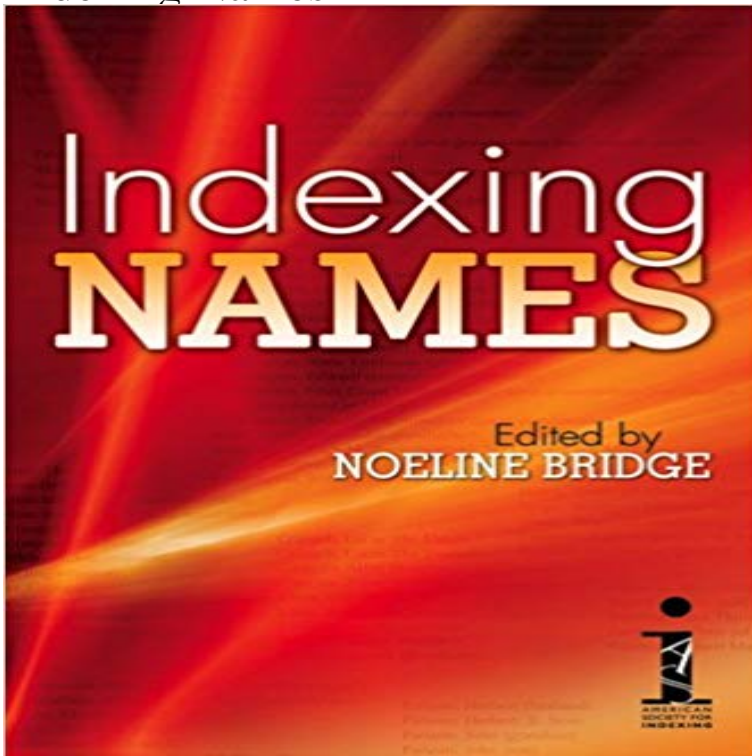


Indexing Names
