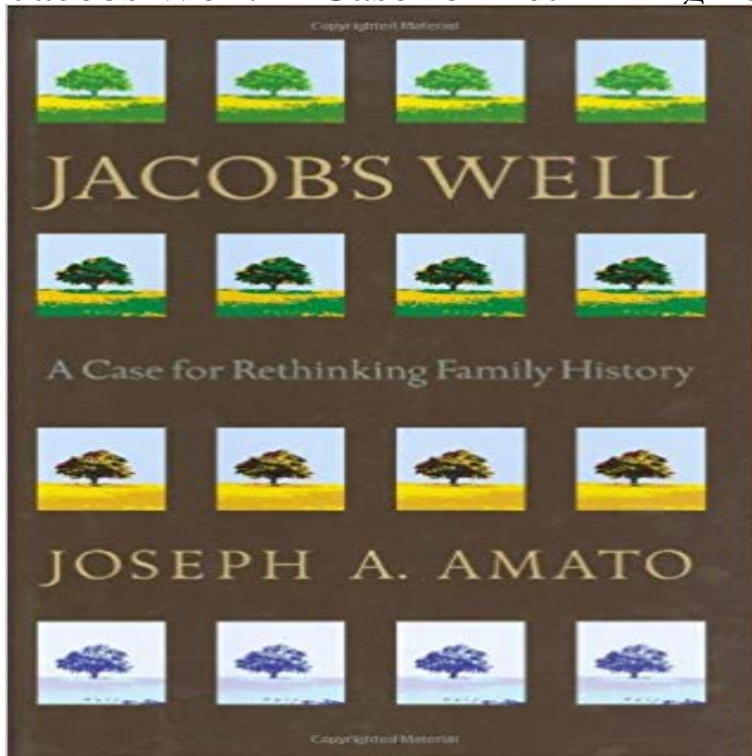


Jacobs Well: A Case for Rethinking Family History
