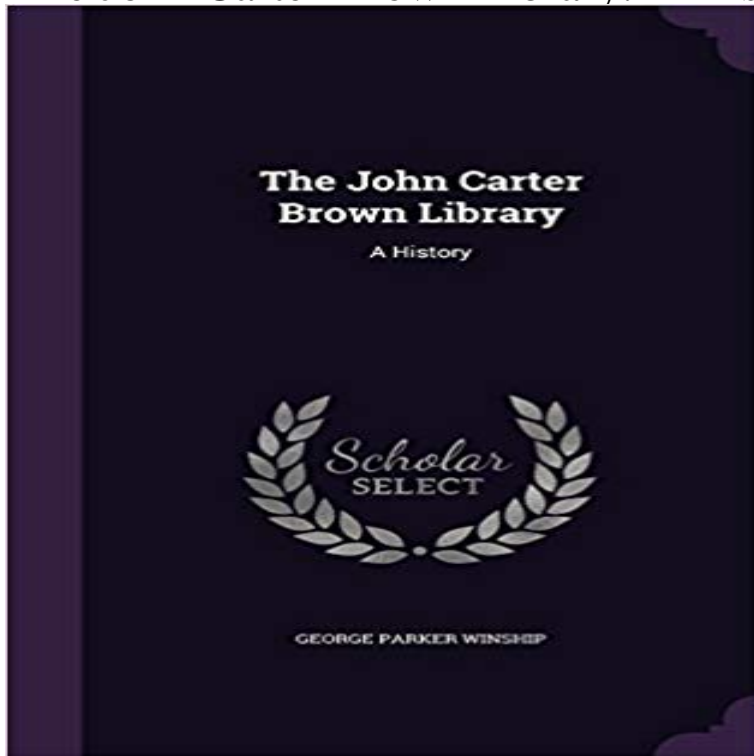


# The John Carter Brown Library: A History
