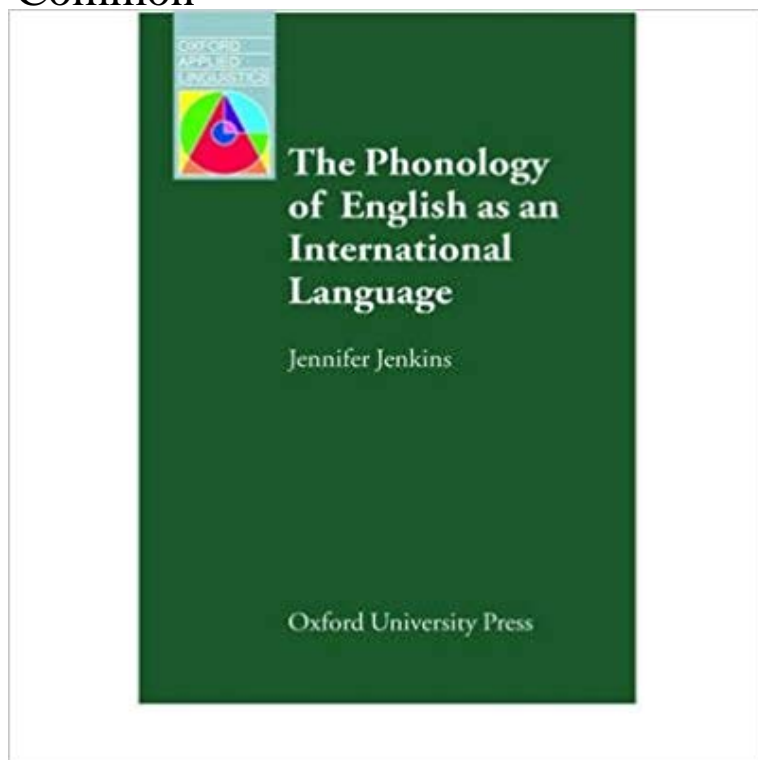


The Phonology of English as an International Language: New Models, New Norms, New Goals (Oxford Applied Linguistics) (Paperback) - Common
